All **experienced** players are welcome to attend the 1st XI/2nd XI trials. Year 9 students' trialling for the 1st XI must have been representative players in 2017.

All other interested hockey players who do not want to trial for the 1st and 2nd XI teams are welcome to attend the Reserve Senior Trials and Junior Trials.

Fees and Registration:

Registrations will be done online this year. This form can be found on the Tauranga Girls' College School website, Sports then Hockey.

There is also a Tauranga Hockey Association player online registration form that must be filled out before a player can play. A Link for this will be on the Hockey page of the TGC website.

The fees for the season cover the Tauranga Hockey Association subscription and building levy fees, turf fees for all games at Blake Park and practices at Tauranga Boys' College, replacement of hockey uniform, goalie equipment and balls.

All girls wishing to trial must complete the **registration form attached** and pay a deposit of **\$100** to the Fees Office by **12 March**. The deposit will only be refunded if we cannot offer your daughter a place in a team due to a shortage of coaches or players.

To be issued with a uniform players must have paid the full amount of fees. Please contact Kaye Barnett (TiC of Hockey) if you should need to arrange an alternative payment schedule either email kbarnett@tgc.school.nz or 578 8114 ext 748.

The \$100 will be deducted from the fees and the remaining amount must please be paid to the Fees Office or by Internet Banking by the end of Term 1. The school bank details are given below. Please ensure that you put "Hockey Fees" and your daughter's name in the reference box.

Managers:

These are confirmed after the teams have been named but are generally parents.

If you are able to coach or manage your daughter's team please indicate this on the Registration Form. There will be a reduction in your daughter's fees for the season if you Coach or Manage a team this year.

Hockey Uniform:

Uniforms will be issued to players once the teams have been decided. All students must have a pair of navy hockey socks. All players also need a pair of plain white socks to wear if there is a clash in uniform. These socks need to be in the players stick bag each week just in case. Navy and white socks can be purchased at the Sports Office for \$15. All players must wear mouth guards and shin pads and will need to bring their own hockey sticks.

Tournaments:

The 1st XI team will be attending the Federation/Marie Fry Tournament and the costs for these will be confirmed closer to the time. The 2nd XI team maybe attending the Chris Arthur 2nd XI Tournament in Ashburton during Winter Tournament Week. It is expected that each team will do some fundraising to help to contribute to the costs of attending these tournaments.
