## Tauranga Girls' College Touch – BOP SS & Zonal Championships

Your daughter has expressed an interest in joining a Tauranga Girls' College Touch team to play in the Bay of Plenty Secondary Schools Touch competition on Sunday 11 March in Rotorua. If the team qualifies at this competition they will compete at the Zonal Championships the following weekend (18 March) also in Rotorua.

- Training times:** Wednesday 7.15am to 8.30am, after school 3.30pm to 5pm at school
- Gear:** Players will be supplied a uniform but must be completely changed for all trainings including wearing appropriate footwear
- Cost:** \$15 for each event
- Competitions:** Bay of Plenty Secondary School Championships 11 March at Neil Park in Rotorua  
Zonal (qualify for Nationals in December) 18 March at Neil Park in Rotorua
- Coach:** Dianne Kahuna
- Manager:** To be confirmed

**Transport to competitions:** The school vans are being used by other sports both weekends so students will need to arrange their own transport to Rotorua. Kaye Barnett, the Sports Co-ordinator, is co-ordinating carpooling however, if this cannot be arranged, then we will need to hire a van which will cost each student another \$15 each day.
