Dear Parent/Guardians

Welcome to the 2018 Junior Competitive Volleyball season. Volleyball provides an opportunity to be involved within the extra-curricular programme at Tauranga Girls' College. The sport is continuing to thrive, be well supported and experience success.

Your daughter is interested in trialling for a Junior Competitive Team. Throughout Term Two and prior to trials, lunchtime skills and games sessions were offered to junior students wanting to learn how to play volleyball. After school training was also available this term to further develop skills and understanding in a more structured setting.

The first Junior Competitive Volleyball Trial will be held on Monday 20 August, Week 5 from 3.45-5.15pm, in the Sports Hall. A second trial will be held on Monday 27 August, Week 6 from 3.45-5.15pm. Once the team lists are finalised, they will be displayed in the gym foyer. This will be by the end of Week 6.

If selected into a competitive team, players will be involved in 1-2 after or before school trainings per week, set by the team coach. There will also be training during the school holidays. The competitive season fee is set at \$90.00. This fee will cover:

- Tuesday or Thursday Night Competition Games beginning 23 October, Term 4
Venue: QEYC (Only the Junior A team will play on a Thursday night beginning Thursday 25 October at QEYC)
- BOP Preliminary and Ranking tournaments, Term 4, held on the following dates:

Students are representing Tauranga Girls' College as members of a sports team and the highest standard of behaviour is expected at all times. These behaviours are reflected in our values of Manaakitanga (Respect), Mahi Tahī (Participation) and Mana Motuhake (Pride).

Another fee will be charged prior to the North Island Indoor Volleyball Championships held Monday 26 November - Friday 30 December in Auckland at the Bruce Pulman Arena, Papakura, Auckland. The Junior A, B and Y9 A Teams will compete at this event. (This fee will be approximately \$400.00).

If your daughter is not selected into a competitive team and opts to play social volleyball, the full season fee will be \$50.00. She will need to collect a social volleyball letter from the Sports Office that contains all the necessary information and listen to the Daily Notices for important messages.

To trial, students must complete an **online registration form**. The URL address is: <https://goo.gl/forms/h3wN3sPTu5ZdATMj2>. This link can also be found by going onto the TGC website at www.tgc.school.nz by clicking on 'sport' and then 'volleyball'. Additionally, a **non-refundable trial fee of \$30** must be paid to the Fees Office on or before Monday 20 August. Students will be unable to trial if this fee has not been paid. This fee will be put towards your daughters' competitive or social season fees.
